The Early Childhood Consultation Partnership (ECCP[®]) is a nationally recognized, evidence based, statewide mental health consultation program, developed to meet the social/emotional needs of children birth to five. ECCP[®] is designed to build the capacity of caregivers by identifying strengths and offering support, education, and consultation, which promotes the most enduring and optimal outcomes for young children.

Position summary: The Assistant Program Manager will provide administrative, clinical, and reflective supervision to Master's level Early Childhood Mental Health Consultants. This includes providing ongoing support to supervisees, ensuring that supervisees are following the ECCP program model and maintaining an accurate data system. The Assistant Program Manager is responsible for completing quarterly data reports for their supervisee workload and communicating with home agency supervisors. In addition, the Assistant Program Manager will provide orientation training for new consultants, continuing education trainings, create program and workforce development curriculum/materials, and attend statewide collaboratives.

Qualifications: Masters Degree in mental health, clinical license required, at least 5 years of related work experience in the field of early childhood mental health, at least 3 years of supervisory experience, excellent organizational skills and writing ability are a must.
